

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTERS 2.32 AND 2.33 OF THE MANITOU SPRINGS MUNICIPAL CODE CONCERNING THE PUBLIC LIBRARY AND THE LIBRARY BOARD

WHEREAS, on November 6, 2012, the electors of the City of Manitou Springs approved a ballot issue under which the City was included into the Pikes Peak Library District;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the ballot issue, an IGA between the City of Manitou Springs and the Pikes Peak Library District, and a lease agreement between the City of Manitou Springs and the Pikes Peak Library District, the Manitou Springs Public Library is no longer being operated by the City of Manitou Springs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Manitou Springs, therefore, desires to repeal the provisions of its Municipal Code establishing the Manitou Springs Public Library and its Library Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANITOU SPRINGS, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1: Chapters 2.32 and 2.33 of the Manitou Springs Municipal Code are hereby repealed, and the Library Board is hereby dissolved.

Section 2: If any article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each part or parts hereof irrespective of the fact that any one part or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

Section 3: The repeal or modification of any provision of Manitou Springs Municipal Code by this ordinance shall not release, extinguish, alter, modify or change in whole or in part any penalty, forfeiture or liability, either civil or criminal, which shall have been incurred under such provision. Each provision shall be treated and held as still remaining in force for the purpose of sustaining any and all proper actions, suits, proceedings and prosecutions for enforcement of the penalty, forfeiture or liability, as well as for the purpose of sustaining any judgment, decree or order which can or may be rendered, entered or made in such actions, suits, proceedings or prosecutions.

Section 4: This ordinance is deemed necessary for the protection of the health, welfare and safety of the community.

Section 5: This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after final approval and adoption on second reading.
