



ONLINE CRASH REPORTING INSTRUCTIONS

This letter is to help inform you and provide detailed instructions for reporting a crash to the State of Colorado, in the event that it meets the following criteria for online reporting.

1. No fatality or injury requiring medical attention was sustained by any person(s) involved in the accident.
2. The accident is not an alleged hit and run or it is an alleged hit and run, and there is no information on the other driver involved in the accident.
3. The accident does not involve damage to any public property other than wildlife.
4. No drivers involved in the accident are suspected of driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs, or have insurance or driver's license violations.

By receiving this form, your incident is likely to fall under one of these criteria as determined by the police officer or dispatcher you spoke with. To fill out the online report, start by going online to the Colorado State Patrol's web page.

You will then go towards the bottom of the page and click the tab "Report to Us". This will open a few more options. Select "File an Online Accident Report". Then follow the reporting form and submit. You will be given a case or reference number you can then submit to your insurance.
