Staffing

- The Task Force has disbanded

Community Policing Update

- Bear project – a few citizens continue. Overall the project is losing energy
- LEEP – 18 camps identified. Working to find a suitable system for clean-up
- Becker's Lane Lodge – Officer found that individuals had established residency. Fire Department conducted a voluntary Fire Inspection with MSPD on site. Officers observed that BLL did not meet Housing Code and issued an order to vacate. Later citations were issued for violating the order to vacate.

Projects

- Records management System (RMS) – collecting quotes to upgrade/replace our old system
- Body Cameras – Collecting quotes and seeking grants
- New Vehicle ordered
- Laptops – Met with manufacturer's representative and awaiting quotes

July 28 – Chamber of Commerce meeting to give PD update

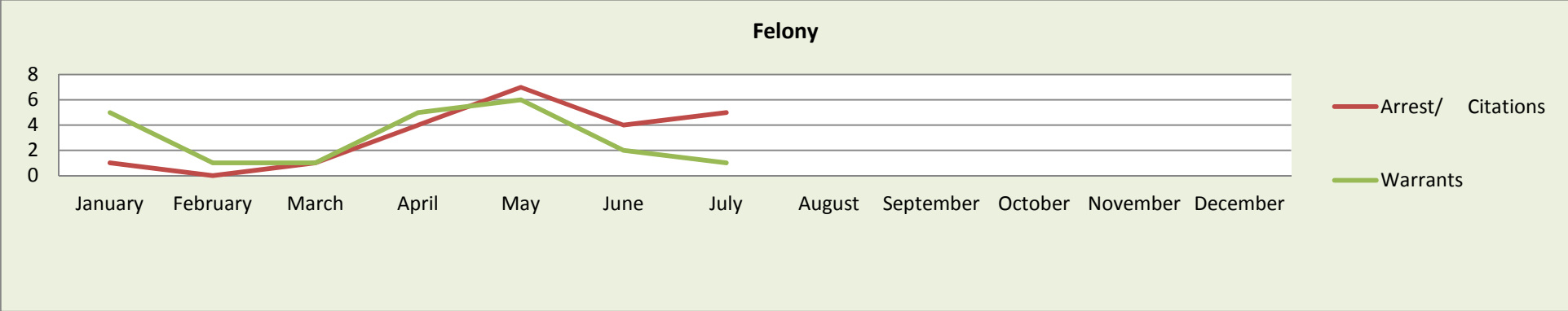
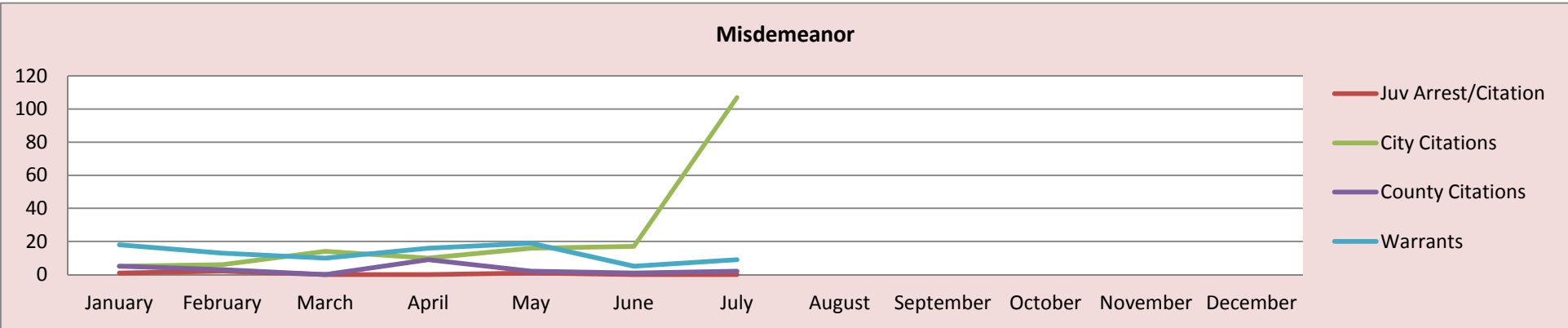
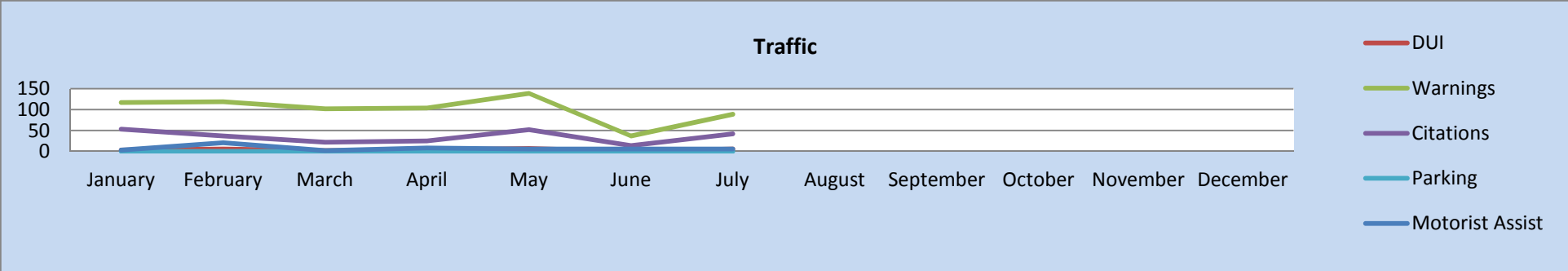
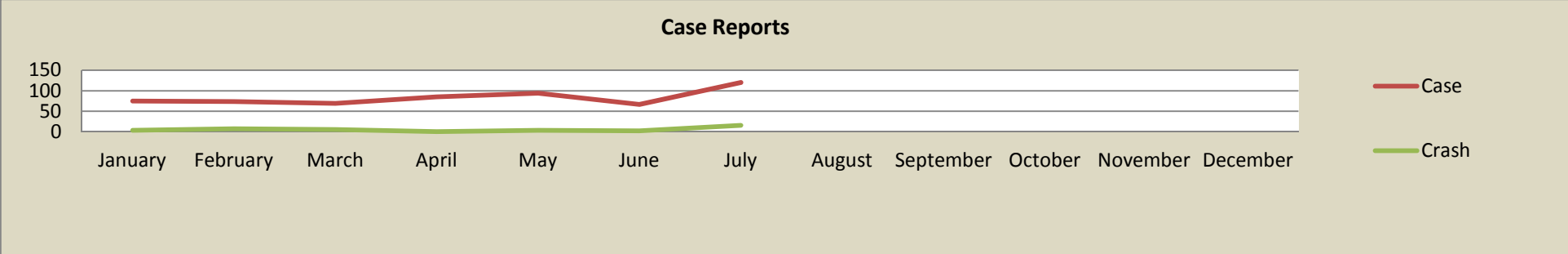

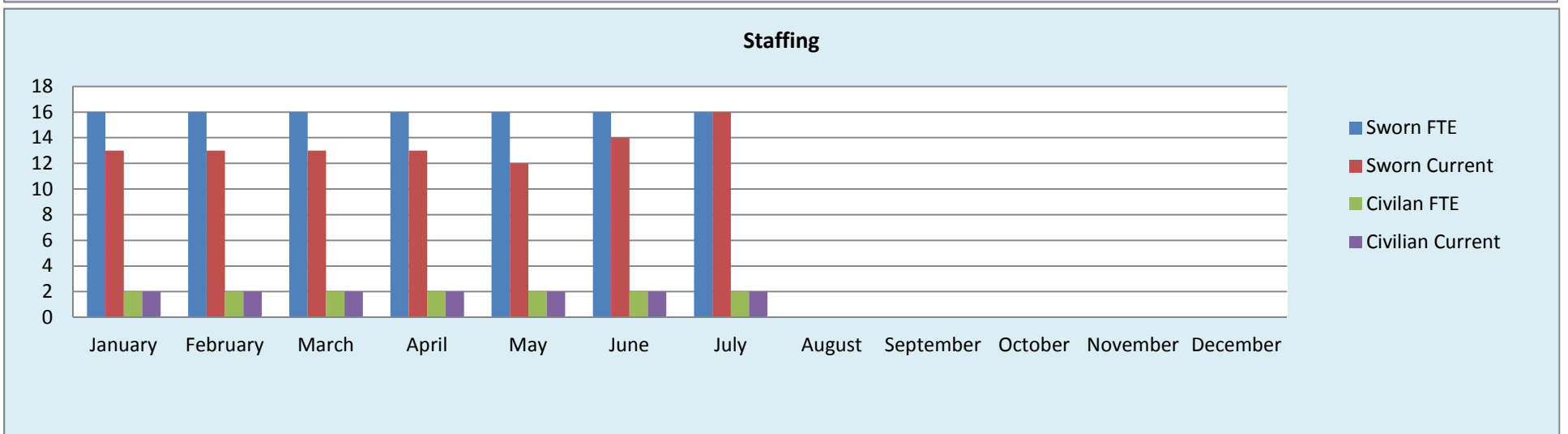
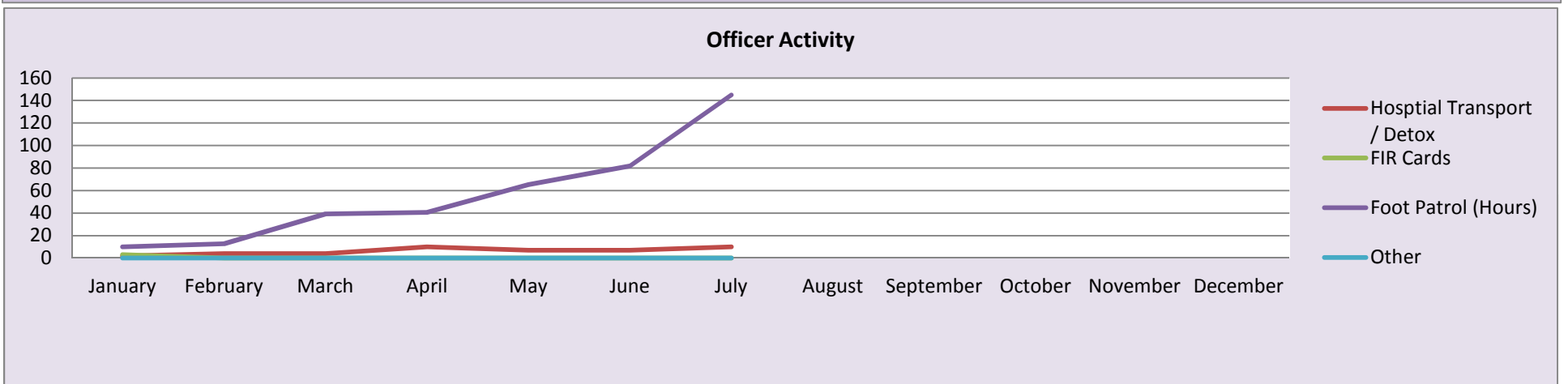
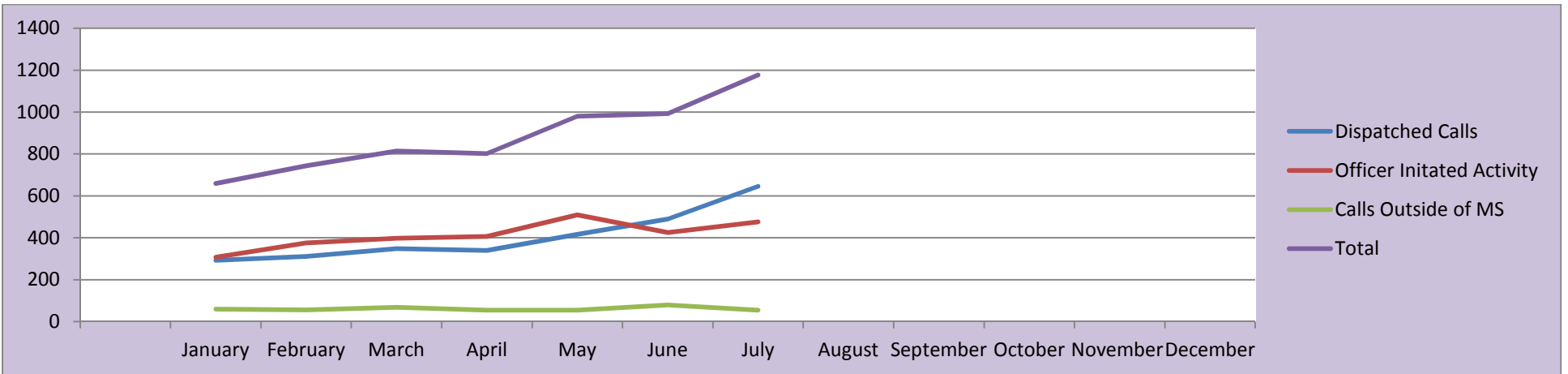
Attempted Murder occurred on HWY24. Motorcyclist shot at a vehicle during a road rage incident. Subject was arrested and charged.
