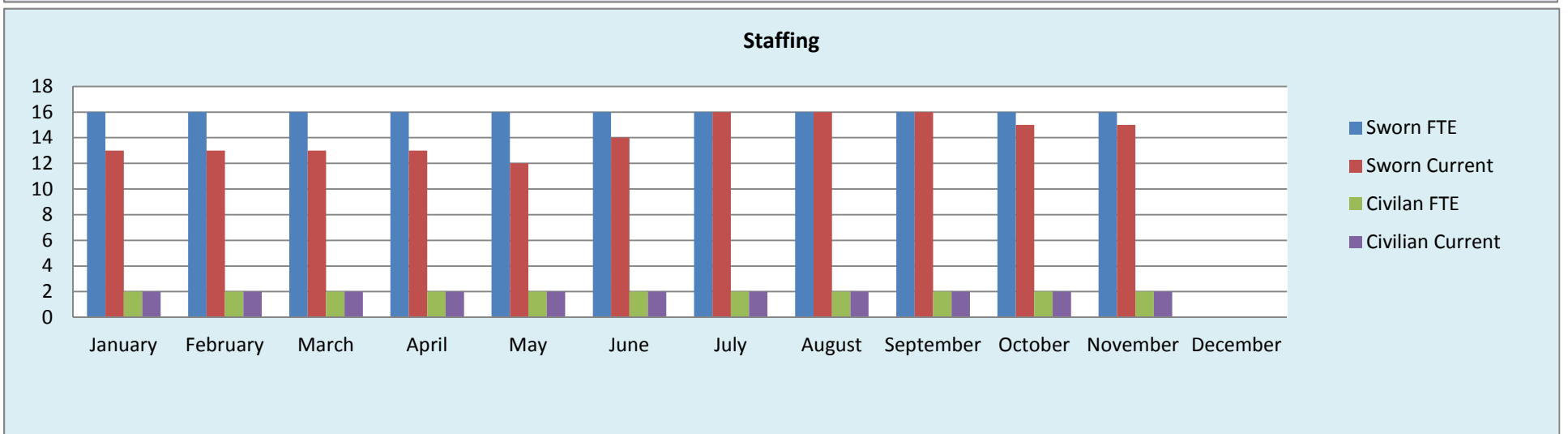
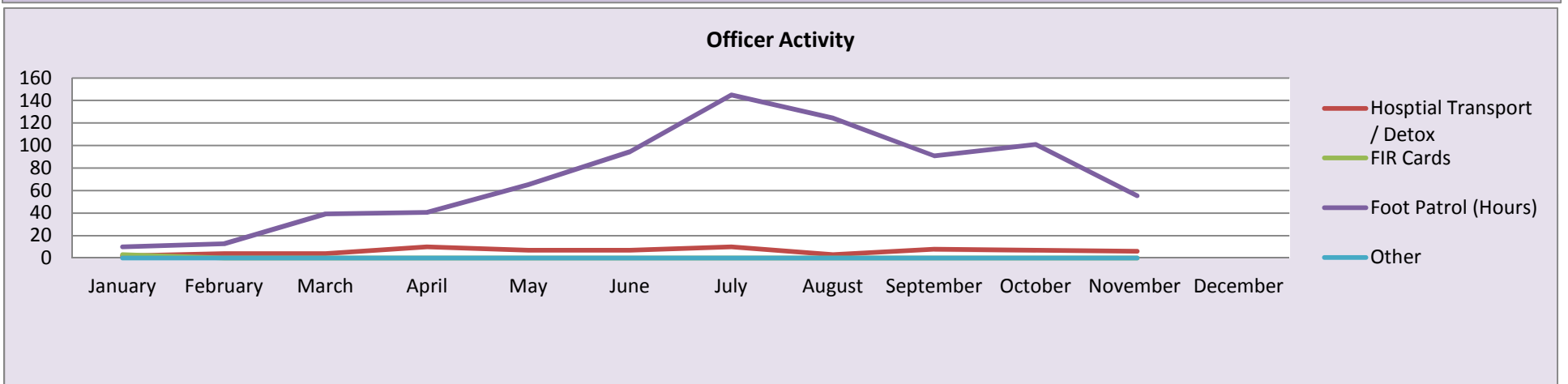
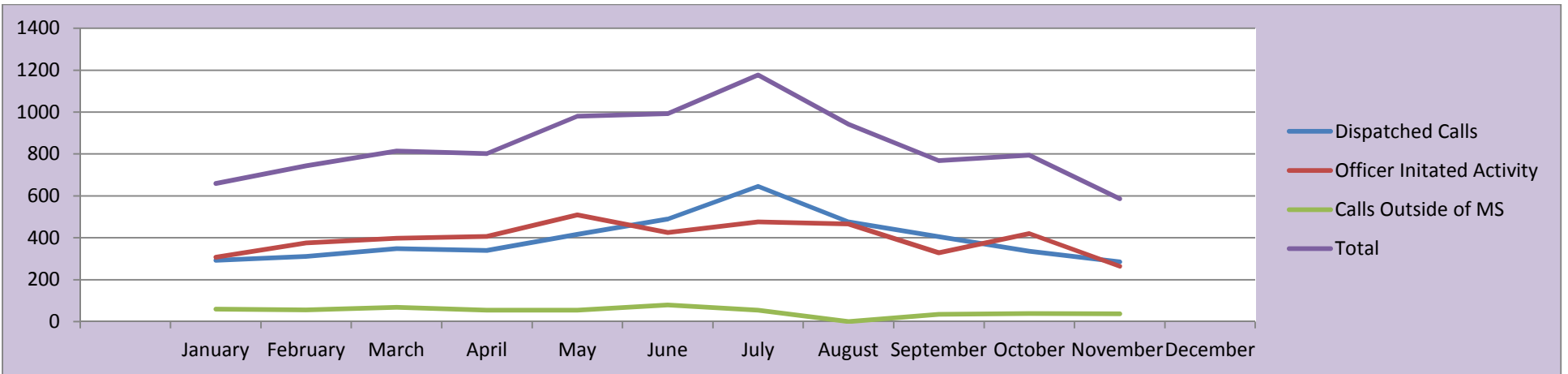
- There were one Sixty Two requests for the presence of the SRO throughout the school district.

Special Projects:

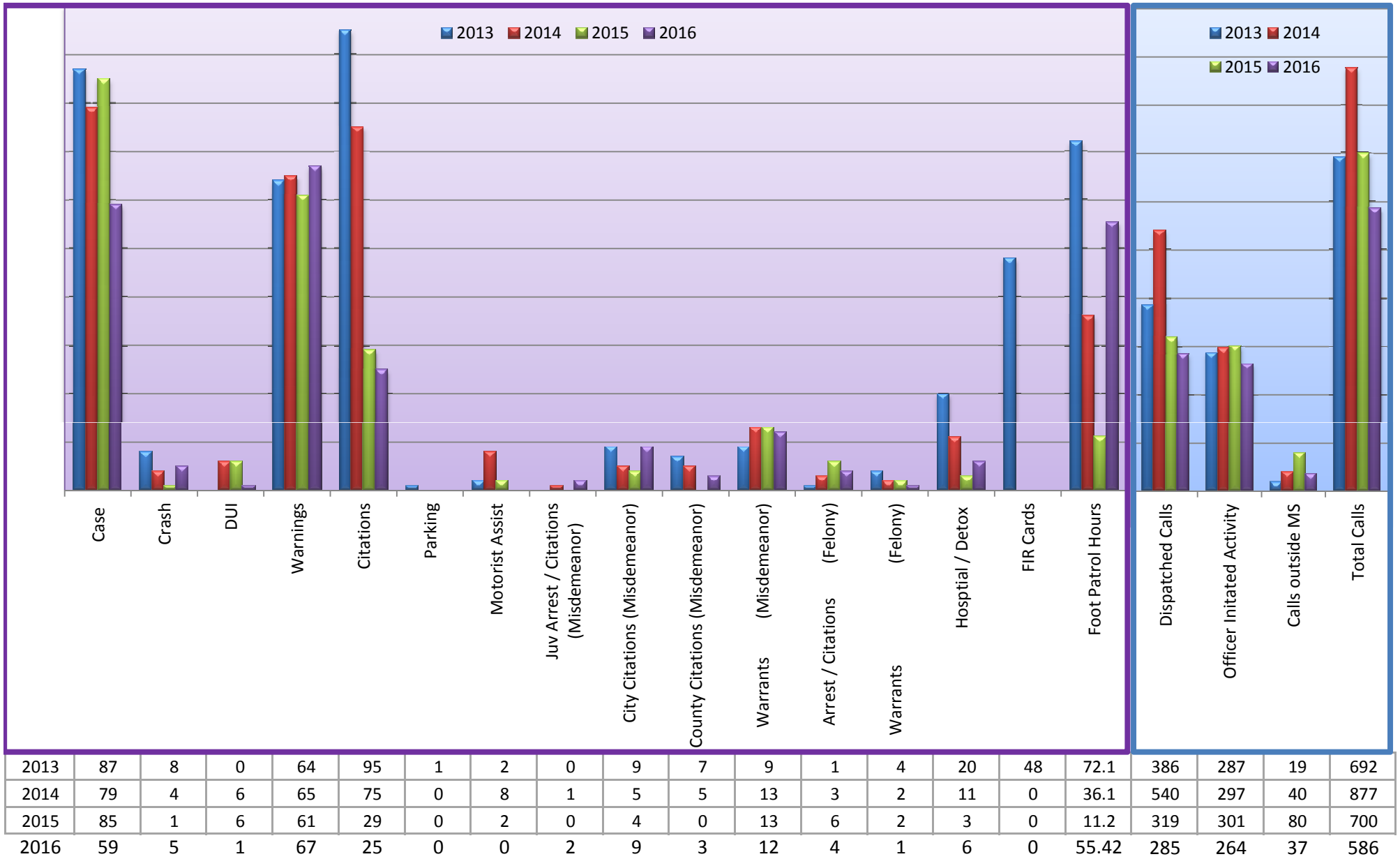
- All district schools participated in Lock Down/Safety drills.
