

## Manitou Springs Police Department Monthly Report May 2017

### Staffing

- Two Vacancies.
- Hiring:
  - Process started with application deadline of February 7th
  - 30 Applications received
  - Three Candidates currently in background check
  - Officer Rathbun started May 15<sup>th</sup>.

### Community Policing Update

- Ruxton Ave plan active. Resumed morning details at the base of the incline.
- LEEP – From Officer Alex Ballard – This month the LEEP program had some scheduling issues, and extra duty camp locates were not completed. Multiple on duty attempts to locate camps were completed. The camp inside the quarry is still active, and we are awaiting permission to clean up the site. A camp in the Intemann trail, near the red mountain trail was located by a resident. The parties responsible for the camp have yet to be located and cited.

### Projects

- Officers are Participating in Click It or Ticket (Grant funded overtime)
- Officers are participating in LEAF grant funded overtime for DUI enforcement
- SARA model training for all officers underway
- EForce Records Management System (RMS)
  - Incident Based Reporting (IBR) automated submission – Continuing to work through testing with CBI in order to become certified.
  - Connection to Community Crime Mapping – The system is set up and we are testing/validating before notifying the public that it is available. You can find it at [www.communitycrimemap.com](http://www.communitycrimemap.com)
- Local Agency Safety Study – Manitou Springs was selected from among twenty other applicants to participate in a CDOT funded traffic safety study. CDOT has hired a consultant to study our system as it relates to traffic crash reduction and pedestrian safety. This will be a broad study of major areas of concern and any additional areas identified by the consultant. This project will have minimal staff engagement and will produce a report of recommendations for short term and long term solutions. We expect the report in late August or early September.

## **Goals Update**

1. “Establish and maintain a sworn officer on foot patrol in the business district for ten hours every day (weather permitting) from May 1st through Labor Day and on weekends from Labor Day through October 31” - We continue to fill walking beats on weekends with good weather. Contract for 2017 EPSO extra Duty is in place. We were able to fill most of May and June walking beats with MSPD officers on voluntary overtime.
2. “Emphasize quality of life issues on the Ruxton corridor and establish a plan and document actions based on local law enforcement capabilities to address those issues.”  
– Presence at the base from 0430-0600 every day when available
3. “Align MSPD staffing with identifiable needs and Council goals and hire sufficient numbers of officers to satisfy those needs.” – See Staffing section above
4. “Continue to develop Manitou Springs Police Department’s public image as staffed by a team of able officers who are engaging and friendly.” No notable activity
5. “The City of Manitou Springs is an enjoyable and rewarding place to work” – SIGMA testing to occurred the first week of April and employees are embarking on renewed commitments to eat well and exercise more.
