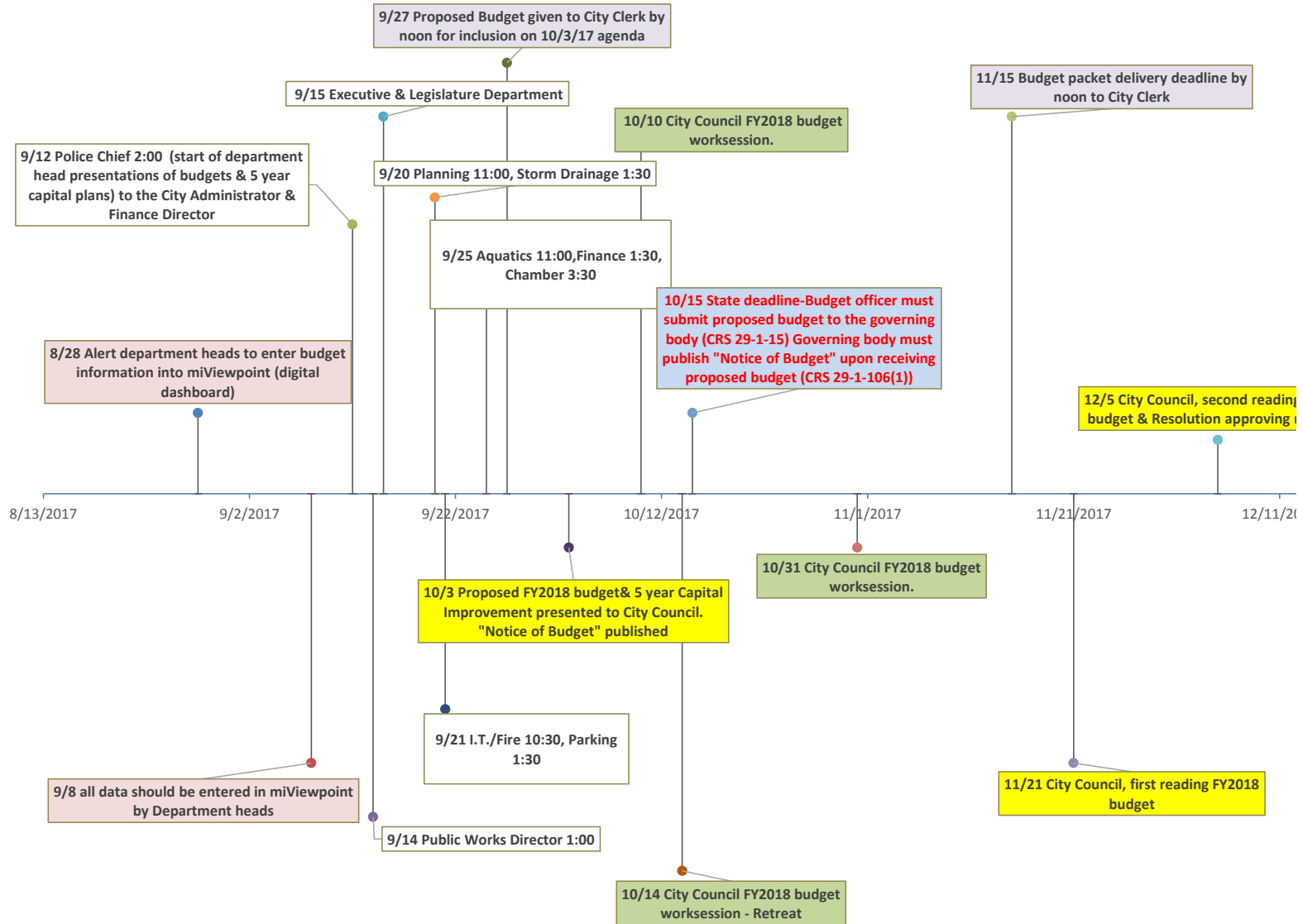

11/21/2017	Tuesday	11/21 City Council, first reading FY2018 budget.
12/5/2017	Tuesday	12/5 City Council, second reading FY2017 budget & Resolution approving mill levy
12/15/2017	Friday	12/15 State Deadline for certification of mill levy to county commissioners. Local governments levying property tax must adopt their budgets before certifying the levy to the county.

The Departments & Funds that will be presented by each department head (if they oversee multiple cost centers) to the City Administrator and the Finance Director:

Police Chief: Police Department, Judicial Department & the Law Enforcement Fund

Public Works Director: Public Works Department, Gen Fund: Parks & Rec acct lines, Public Works Fund, Conservation Trust Fund, PPRTA Fund, El Paso /Beckers Fund, Water & Sewer Funds.

Planning Director: Planning Department, Open Space Fund, and if needed Conservation Trust Fund (Parks & Rec and Open Space advise for this fund)

Finance Director: Finance Department, General Fund-Misc Expenditures, Downtown Improvement Fund, & Capital Improvement Fund
