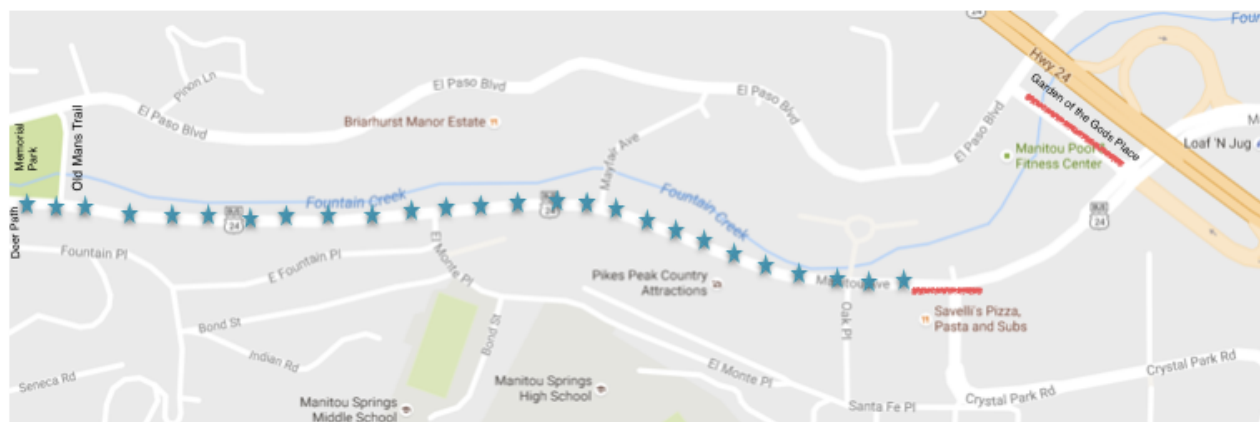
### Additional Traffic Impacts Week of Dec. 4

#### Eastbound Manitou Avenue Right Lane Closure

- Motorists will experience a 24-hour closure on the eastbound right lane of Manitou Avenue at Crystal Park Road for curb and gutter work. The eastbound left lane of Manitou Avenue will remain open. All businesses will have access.
  - Friday, Dec. 2 through Friday, Dec. 9
  - Crews will be working Saturday, Dec. 3 and Monday, Dec. 5 through Friday, Dec. 9, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

#### Temporary No Parking Zones and Turn Lane Restrictions on Manitou Avenue

- Motorists will experience intermittent no parking zones and turn lane restrictions on Manitou Avenue between Deer Path and Crystal Park Road for sidewalk and pedestrian ramp work.
  - Monday, Dec. 5 through Friday, Dec. 9, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily.

### Site B Closure

Motorists will experience a full closure at **Garden of Gods Place between El Paso Boulevard and Manitou Avenue until late Dec.** This closure allows for bridge, barrier and drainage work. **Please note the increased time to address additional drainage issues.**

### Washington Bypass Closure

Washington Bypass is currently closed for the Manitou Springs Slope Stabilization Project. It will be closed for construction activities with a completion anticipated December 27.

## Schedule Change

### Site B - Manitou Avenue Paving Phase

Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) announced that the milling and paving phase of the Manitou Avenue Overlay Project has been delayed until Spring 2017. The community will be informed prior to the start of the paving work. All paving is scheduled to be complete before the Memorial Holiday weekend.

### Site B - Garden of the Gods Place between El Paso Boulevard and Manitou Avenue

The project team will complete the drainage work at Garden of the Gods Place and Manitou Avenue and all Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) ramp work on Manitou Avenue by late Dec. 2016.

### Project Information

The \$2.4 million CO 24 East Manitou Avenue Road Improvements project -- consists of an overlay through Manitou Springs along with Americans with Disabilities (ADA) ramp work. The project entails milling, paving, ADA ramps (approximately 30), drainage inlet and pipes, adjustments to manholes and water valves, bridge deck repairs and pavement striping.
