



FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

The City of Manitou Springs will be utilizing PPRTA maintenance funds for the 2017 Street Mill and Overlay Program, approved Capital Improvement Plan. This year's project will also install several ADA ramps through the City, and crack seal at numerous locations to improve pavement longevity. The project will begin on April 24th, and will be completed by May 26th, the public may experience detours and slowing in these areas during construction.

The following streets will be milled and a new layer of asphalt will be placed:

- Pawnee Ave. from Manitou Ave. to Prospect Pl.
- Crystal Hills Blvd. from Manitou Ave. to Palisade Ave.
- Minnehaha Ave. from Manitou Ave. to Pine Ridge Ave.
- Osage Ave. from Ruxton Ave. to Mohawk St.
- Navajo Ave. from Manitou Ave. to Osage Ave.
- Crystal Park Rd. from Crystal Hills Blvd. to the southern City Limits.

Along with the mill and overlay program, PPRTA funds will also be utilized to reseal the Hiawatha Garden's Parking Lot on Old Man's Trail. The parking lot will be open throughout this project, which is scheduled to begin on April 24th and be completed by May 3rd. Activity will occur primarily in the morning hours to avoid conflict with adjacent businesses.
