

MUST BE SUBMITTED AT LEAST 30 DAYS PRIOR TO YOUR EVENT ONLY THE PERSON(S) RENTING CITY FACILITIES WILL BE CONSIDERED ELIGIBLE TO APPLY ALCOHOL AFFIDAVIT REQUIRES PAYMENT OF A \$30 FEE

The dispensing of alcohol beverages in a public place carries with it the responsibility to promote responsible alcohol consumption and help ensure that excessive consumption does not occur. The two key areas of concern are **serving to underage individuals** and **serving to intoxicated individuals**. The following describes two important serving guidelines for alcohol beverages:

• DO NOT SERVE A PERSON WHO IS UNDER THE AGE OF 21 YEARS

Anyone appearing to be under the age of 21 years should be asked for picture identification, preferably a valid driver's license, before being served.

DO NOT SERVE A PERSON WHO APPEARS TO BE INTOXICATED

Those responsible for serving alcohol should monitor the amount of alcohol consumed by guests and should be aware of any behavior changes that may occur as a result of drinking alcohol. Some reactions to watch for include slurred speech, poor coordination, dazed/glassy look in the eyes, aggressiveness, inability to complete sentences, swaying or drowsiness, spilling drinks or food, walking into people, inability to sit up straight, stumbling into objects, bloodshot eyes, inappropriate laughter, and inappropriate volume of speech.
