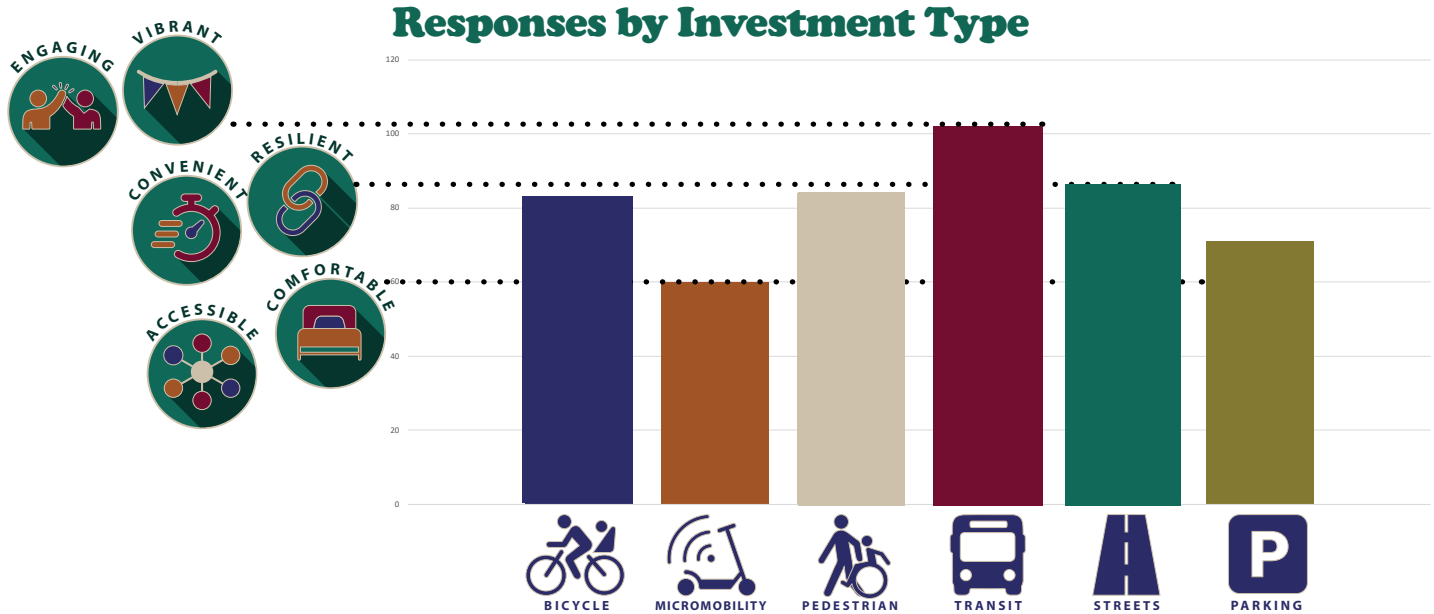


Mantou Springs Transportation & Mobility Master Plan: Strategy Outreach Summary

307 PARTICIPANTS

There were 27 open house workshop attendees, in addiotn to 95 at "Pop-up" engagement at an Ice Cream Social and 185 at the Pikes Peak Ascent/Marathon.

TRANSIT

- Uniquely branded shuttle
- Destination shuttle to Garden of Gods, Seven Falls, Cheyenne Mtn. Zoo
- Gondola or alternative "people mover"



PEDESTRIAN

- Signalize pedestrian crossings
- Rehabilitate local stairways and create engaging wayfinding with sense of
- Shared roadway design (Woonerf) on Lovers Lane



STREETS

- Alternative route to Ruxton Avenue
- Extend downtown reach east by reconfiguring roads around Memorial Park, potential civic
- Traffic calming on straight roads & more neighborhood safety improvements



BICYCLE

- Ensure Creekwalk is built
- Extend bike lanes on Manitou Avenue & climbing lanes on steep roads
- Utilize Manitou Avenue side streets as bike boulevards (El Paso, Fountain,



PARKING

- Satellite parking in East and West sides of town with transit connecting them to downtown
- Only joint development or mixed use parking structures allowed around downtown
- Real time wayfinding & advanced warning of parking capacity



MICROMOBILITY

- Create appropriate policies & regulations before
- Include micromobility options at satellite parking & future transit hub
- Encourage innovative transportation network companies
