Laws Bicyclists and Drivers Need to Know:

Where Should Bicyclists Be - Bicyclists should ride as far to the right as they judge safe in current conditions, but can use the full lane for their safety.

3ft To Pass - Drivers must leave at least 3 feet of space when passing a bicyclist, even when they are in a bike lane. Drivers can cross the double yellow line to do so as long as there is clear visibility and no oncoming traffic.

Bicyclists must ride with the flow of traffic

Crossing a Bike Lane - Bicyclists and other authorized users have the right of way in bike lanes. Drivers can only use a bike lane when safely preparing for and executing a right turn, including yielding to bicyclists before doing so.
